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## Report Overview

This document forms the Qualifying Explanatory Statement to demonstrate how Elopak intends to achieve carbon neutrality under the guidelines of PAS 2060:2014.

<b>Subject of PAS 2060 declaration</b>	<p>This report includes all Elopak's operations, excluding JV's in Saudi Arabia, Dominican Republic and Mexico as these are Elopak joint ventures and are considered to be outside of the footprint boundary.</p> <p>Included are all scope 1, 2 and 3 greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions from Elopak's operations in the following countries; Austria, Canada, Czech Republic, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, The Netherlands, Hungary, Ireland, Israel, Italy, Norway, Russia, Serbia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Ukraine, UK, USA and Poland.</p> <p>As far as we are aware, there have not been any changes to the organisational boundary in the footprint year and we are not aware of any other owned facilities excluded by Elopak from this boundary.</p> <p>We have taken the operational data provided in Footprinter™ and spreadsheets as correct.</p>
<b>Description of Subject</b>	Elopak is an international supplier of paper-based packaging solutions for liquid food. Based in Norway, and wholly owned by the Ferd Group (one of Norway's largest privately owned industrial groups).
<b>Rationale for selection of the subject</b>	The scope and subject of this PAS 2060 includes all emissions based on the operational control principle defined in the WBCSD / WRI GHG Protocol – Corporate Standard.
